Southeast Asia is experiencing remarkable social and demographic changes which have the potential to profoundly alter genderbased roles and resources within families and intergenerational relationships. society; support and caregiving; and family life course transitions into (and out of) marital and parental roles. Increasing levels of crossborder mobility in the region introduce additional, novel changes and challenges to family life in both migrant sending and receiving communities. **Opportunities** for innovative research at the intersection of family, gender and development are many. This research will likely be enriched by engaging collaborative, interdisciplinary and international teams of researchers.
